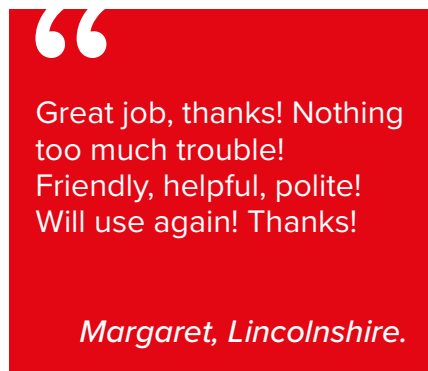
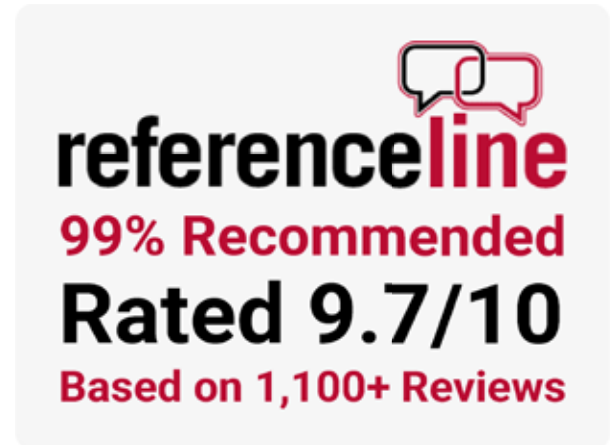

The Storage Process

1



Our wooden storage containers are stored in our purpose-built, safe, secure warehouse at Markham Moor.

2



When you book us to collect your goods for store, the empty containers are loaded onto our specialist trucks with specially designed side opening doors.

3



Our truck with the empties and crew then travel to your collection address.

4



Each container has a serial number. As we load, we create an inventory of goods for each container.

5



We use a specially designed ramp and loading system to load and stow your goods safely.

6



The containers are wooden, most boxes are cardboard and the transit protection we use is a wool/nylon mix. This means the goods are well insulated, protected and can 'breathe'.




We seal each container at the point of collection.



The truck then returns to our storage facility.

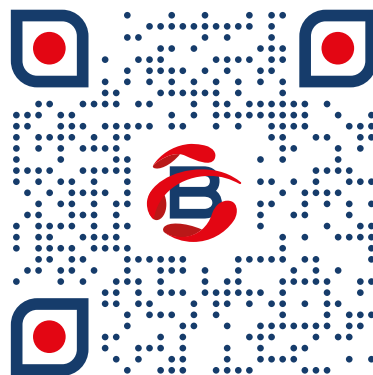


Our forklift then removes the full containers into the warehouse and stows them in a recorded position within our container system.



Your goods can then be stored
for as long as required.
We charge by the container by
the week.

As soon as you are ready for
delivery from store, just let us
know - the process is exactly
the same but in reverse.

How We Move

Our Pre-Move Survey

We'll visit you before your move day to discuss your requirements and our experienced estimator will carry out a pre-move survey. From here, we'll give you a written, fixed-price quotation.

Moving Day

Move day is also known as completion day. On this day, you are obliged to vacate your current property by 2pm and in turn you should get the keys to your new property then. Your move will be planned to help you meet your legal obligations and be clear of your current property in time.

Your moving schedule will be planned assuming that you will get keys between 2-3pm. If yours is a large move there, we will potentially opt to get your essentials delivered on completion day and then finish the delivery and set up the following morning. This enables us to manage the welfare of our crews, and their finish times, prevents deliveries going late in to sometimes dark nights and removes a significant amount of pressure from your completion day.

When should I book my move?

We will generally come and carry out a pre-move survey after you have accepted an offer on your current home. Your precise destination may not be confirmed at this stage. We can then provide you with a formal written quotation, that will outline our suggested method and highlight all suggested inclusions and exclusions with your move.

At this stage, your solicitors will be working on the conveyancing. All solicitors work towards the exchange of contracts. When contracts are exchanged, this means your solicitor is comfortable that you can buy your new property and your buyer is good to buy your property. At the point of exchange, your completion day is then set in stone; this will enable you to sort your broadband, telephones, electricity suppliers etc along with booking us for your move.

At this point, because your move day is set when you book in our diary, the crews and vehicles are allocated to your move and at this point we ask you to pay for your move. We are members of the BAR payment protection scheme, so your payment is safe and secure. If you are packing your own boxes and want to start before you exchange contracts, we ask for a £200 payment to cover the cost of the materials and delivery - this is then deducted from your final bill.

Your Moving Day Checklist

Moving is one of the most stressful things you can do, but a little planning can help to minimise the stress on the day.

Before your move day

- ☐ Confirm your move date with Ballards and your solicitor
- ☐ Collect packing boxes from Ballards and begin getting things boxed up and prepared
- ☐ Dispose of anything you don't want
- ☐ Arrange for tradesmen to disconnect kitchen appliances, including washing machine
- ☐ Organise for readings of your gas, electricity, telephone and water meters to be taken
- ☐ Start running down your fridge/freezer
- ☐ Clear the loft, sort out garage and garden shed. Drain any fuel from lawnmowers/motorcycles before transporting
- ☐ If appropriate, make arrangements for your children to be looked after
- ☐ Organise transport for your pets
- ☐ If you're moving in or out of a block of flats, arrange to have use of the manual override key or priority use of the lift
- ☐ Advise Ballards about parking restrictions at both addresses
- ☐ Notify TV license, passport, car licence and registration office
- ☐ Notify your banks, credit card and insurance company
- ☐ Notify your doctor, dentist, optician and vet
- ☐ Notify your telephone company, tv and internet provider
- ☐ Notify all creditors
- ☐ Arrange to re-route any mail
- ☐ Ensure Ballards are booked and paid for one week prior to move day

Day before the move

- ☐ Defrost your fridge/freezer
- ☐ Pack everything for your first night and morning in your new home, such as nightwear, towels, wash bag, change of clothing, breakfast foods, and crockery/cutlery. Don't forget the kettle and toilet roll! A takeaway is probably the best option for your evening meal on moving day
- ☐ Assemble a box of refreshments. Include sandwiches and snacks, tea and coffee, long-life milk and soft drinks
- ☐ Prepare your plants for transit
- ☐ Pack valuables and important documents securely, you will probably wish to transport these yourself
- ☐ Find and label keys for your purchaser
- ☐ Remove any fixtures you are taking

On the move day

- ☐ Have TV aerials or satellite dishes taken down if they are part of the move
- ☐ Make sure that the meters have been read. Keep a note of the readings
- ☐ Before the removal van departs, take a final look around the property and check you haven't forgotten anything. Responsibility is yours to see nothing is moved in error
- ☐ Ensure you have left operating instructions for the central heating, etc...
- ☐ Lock all doors and windows
- ☐ Leave the keys for collection by the purchaser (or landlord), as arranged
- ☐ Ensure the removal crew has directions to your new property and a phone number to contact you
- ☐ Agree a time of arrival
- ☐ Arrive at your new property, with the keys, before the removal van
